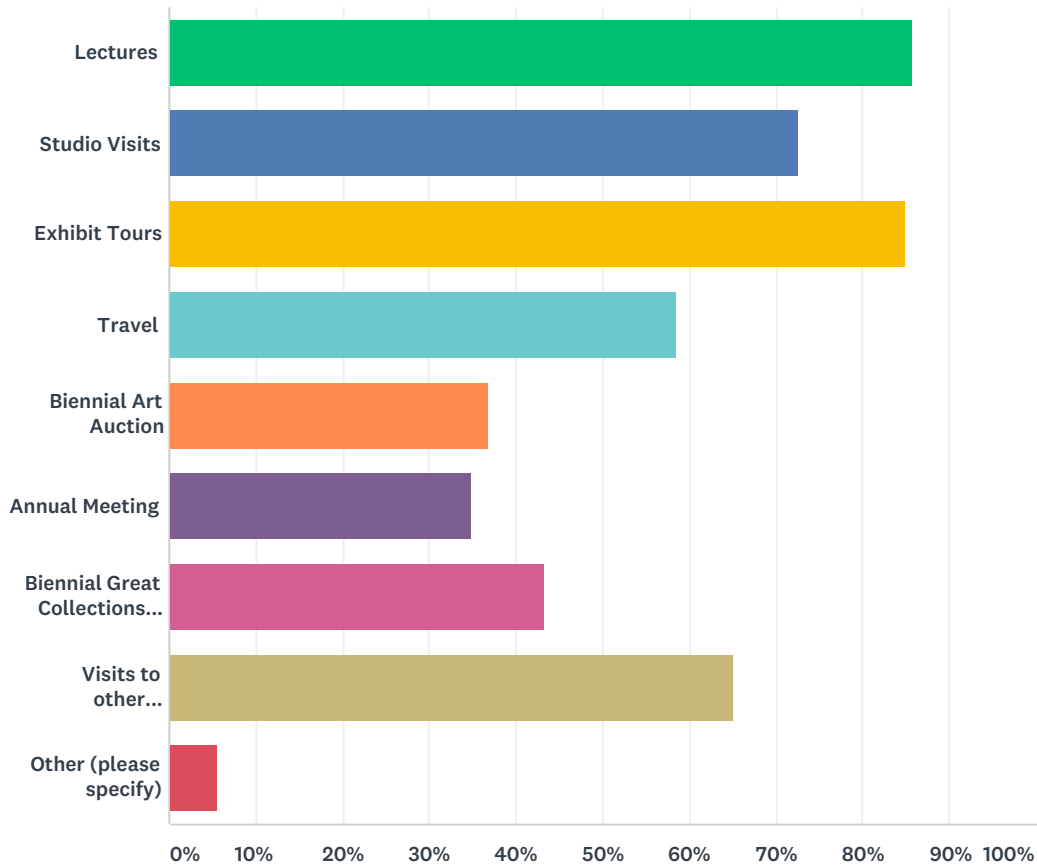

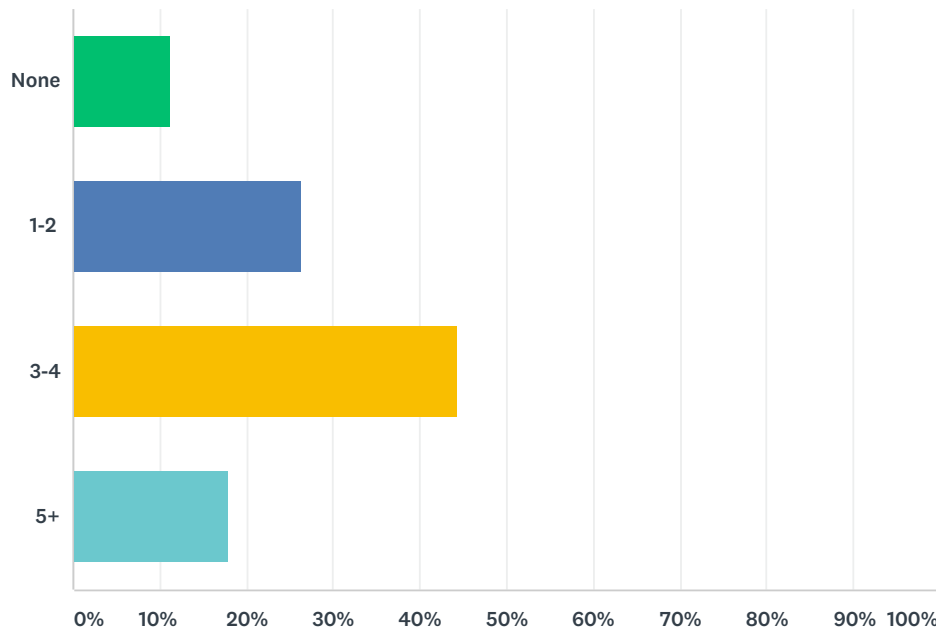

## Q2 How many local (non-travel) FOPAS programs did you attend this past year?

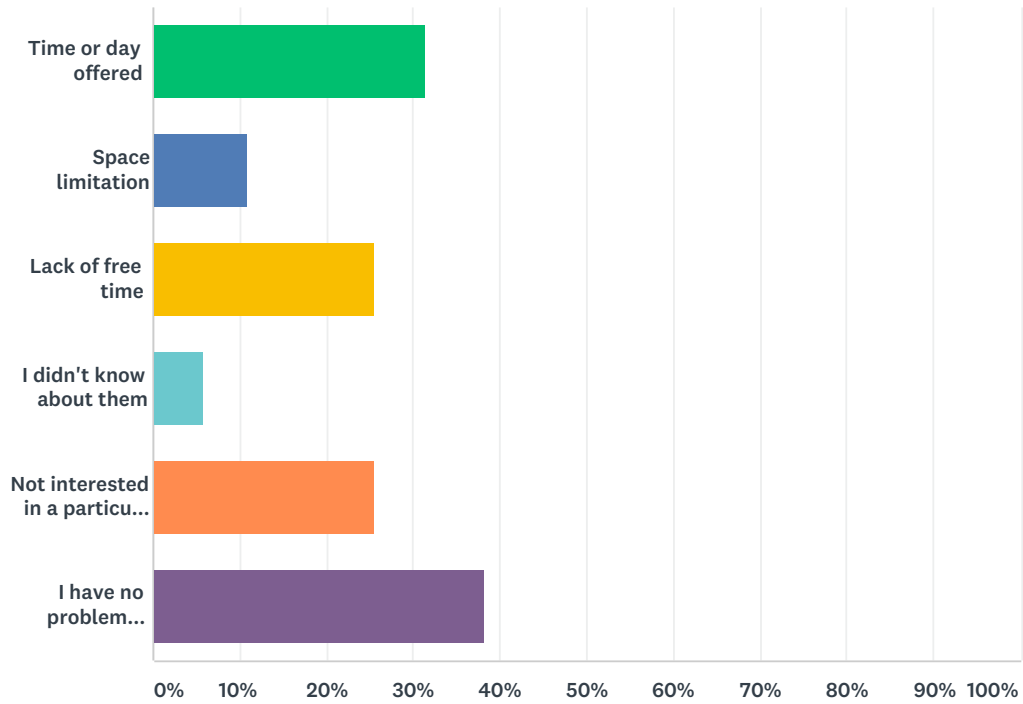

### Q3 I don't often attend events because of (check all that apply):

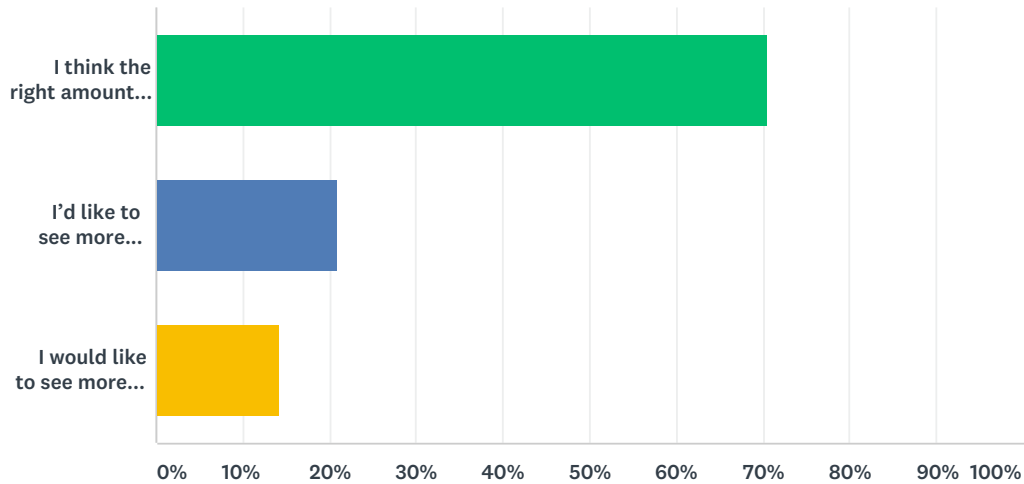

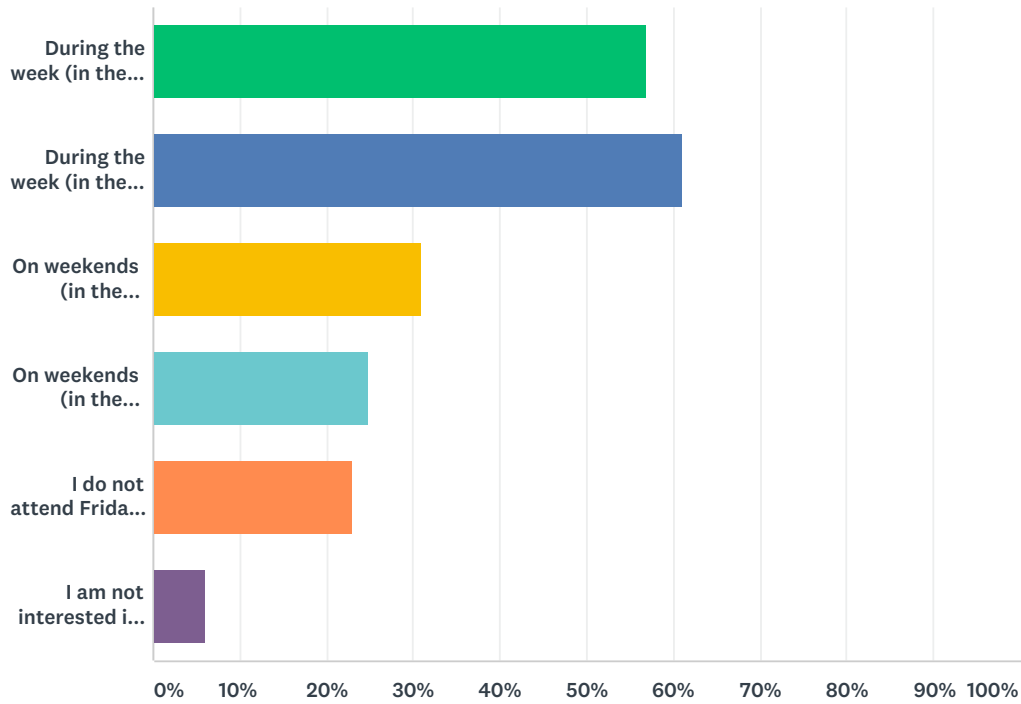

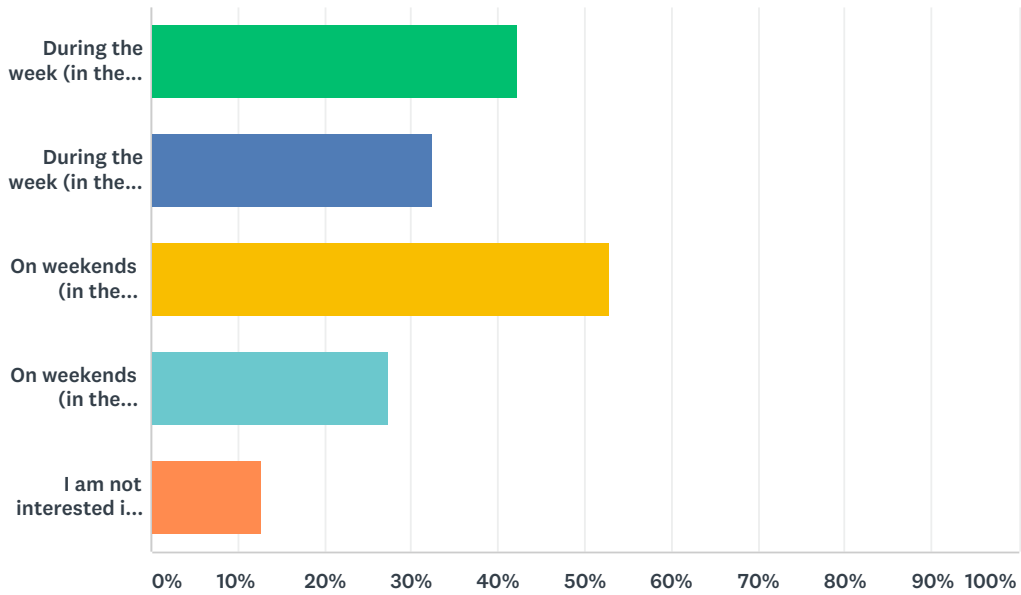

### Q6 I prefer attending studio visits (check all that apply):

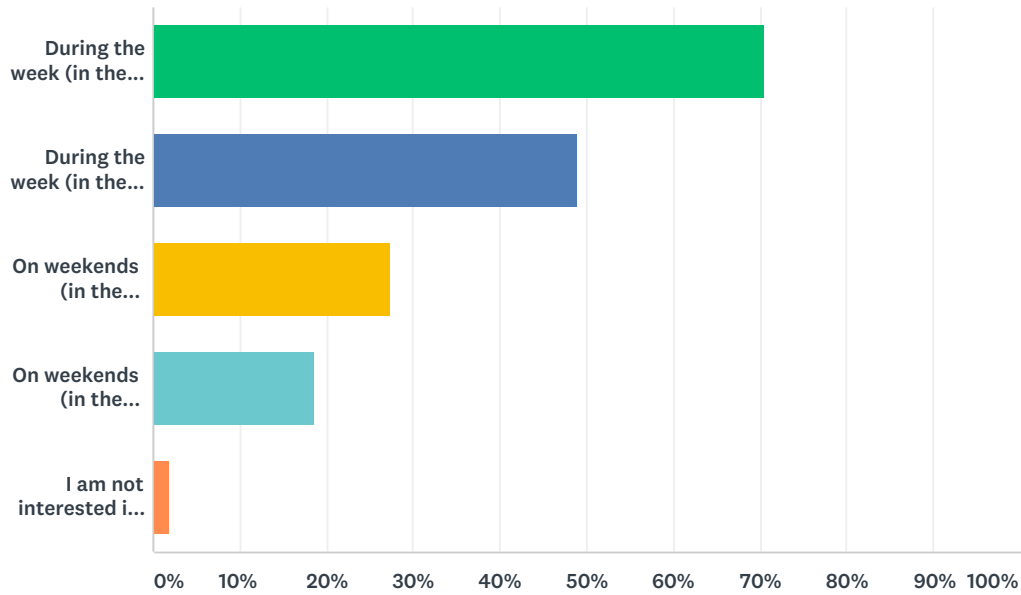

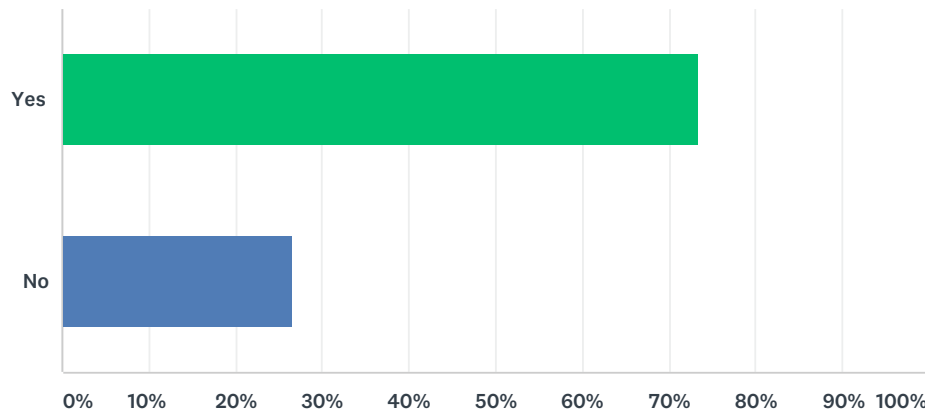

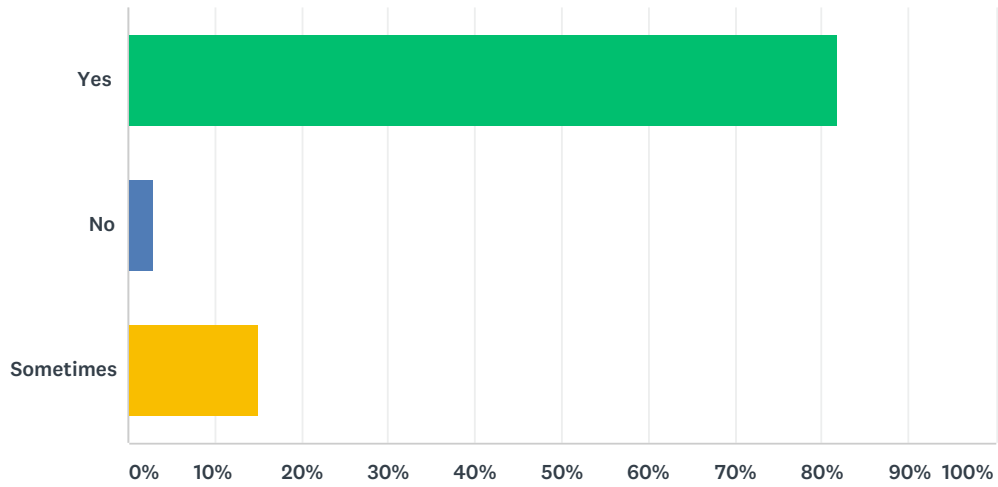

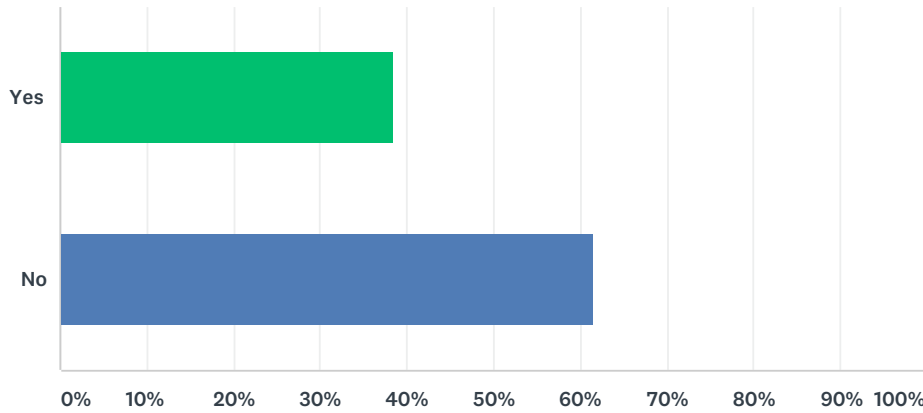

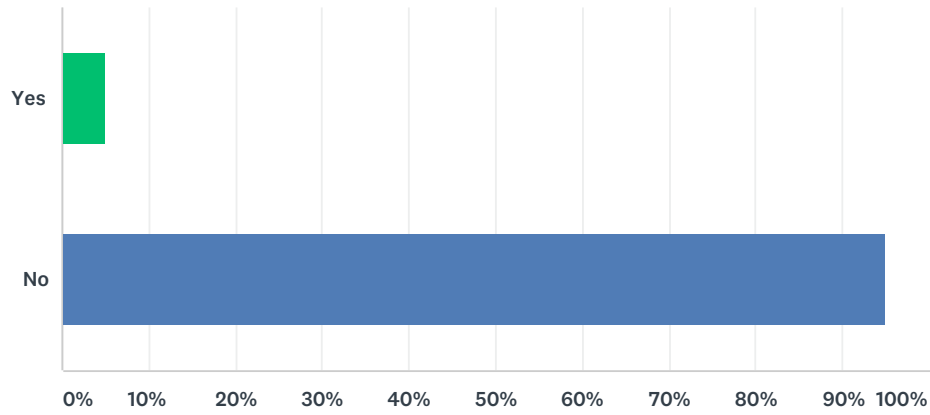
